Objectives and Expected Outcomes

The objective of the project;

- to develop the implementing capacity of EIA in Lao PDR and Sri Lanka through the bilateral twinning arrangement with Japan as a mentoring country.
- The twinning arrangement provides mutual hands-on learning opportunities among the government officials in charge and experts in the field and delivers tangible outputs that are beneficial to mentee countries.

The expected outcomes are:

- an increased capacity of EIA implementation in priority sectors
 - the government officials' capability to instruct project proponents to prepare appropriate EIA preparation documents (Terms of reference etc.)
 - evaluate EIA reports prepared by the project proponents
- an increased exposure and understanding to the newer technologies at mentee countries.

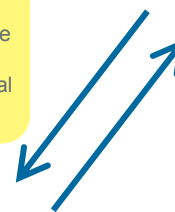
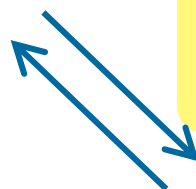

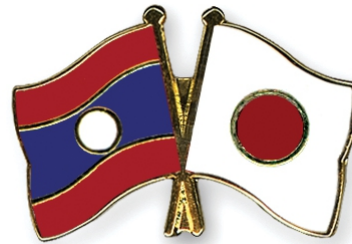
