- Acceptable mitigations for common impacts.
- Aspects to be monitored during implementation

3. Municipal Solid Waste

- Waste to Energy Projects
- Incinerators

- Drawbacks & advantages of each system
- Identification of potential /Direct/ Indirect Impacts of above projects
- Acceptable mitigations for common impacts
- Aspects to be monitored during implementation
